Update from Co-Founder Harley Sheets

Hello members. Good to be corresponding again. Being the first newsletter this year, you have probably wondered when one would appear. Editor Gary Mc-Grady has done exceptional work with the ones he has brought forth, but things haven't gone as planned since he replaced me. He had hoped for a job where he would have worked four days on and four off, which would have made for a great situation. It didn't work out but a better job did. Gary says that he would have accepted the lesser paying job, which would have been ideal for publishing Boxscore, had it have come about. Along with his new position, which has been an adjustment do to the hours involved, Gary's responsibilities of helping his wife Tina with raising their three young daughters, tending to his farm, attending to his trusteeship of Cain Township, maintaining an outstanding website and the publishing of Boxscore became a little too much. Due to the time consumed by these things it has made it difficult for him to allocate enough time to be as diligent as he would like to be, when trying to publish an error free chronicle of Indiana high school basketball, so a change was needed.

Thus, Jerry "Rocky" Kenworthy and myself have agreed to take over for Gary, a least for a while. At the last Board meeting on April 22, along with the election of new officers (listed above), some other issues were addressed. We voted to make the membership dues come due on January 1, instead of the middle of the year (July 1). Thus the members with dues paid up, at least, through July 1 of this year (2006) have a free six month gratis period until January 1, 2007. This will help to compensate for the lack of Boxscores so far this year. The board believes this arrangement would be con-

ducive to making it easier for members to remember when to pay dues and make it more easily explained by the editors and treasurer. Now when the membership receives their newsletters all they have to do is look at the address label and take note. If the label shows 2006, that means the member has paid for that year and that his/her next payment should be in by January 1, 2007 for the year of 2007.

The IHSBHS in publishing the Boxscore with the ever increasing economy has pretty much held the line on cost. We are not in this thing for the money. We started out in 1996 at \$5.00 for membership dues which is used to defray the cost of the newsletter. Over the eleven years of publication we have raised dues, but once to \$6.00 and will do our best to contimue at this level. We may, however, cut down to 2 or 3 issues per year. The key word being may. We'll see. For example, the Indianapolis Postcard Club of which I am a member, has raised their dues from \$5.00 when I first joined in 1994, to \$10.00 currently. This I don't understand. We have close to \$6,000 in our treasury. As vice-president I have always voted against a raise.

With all that has been said, the officers and other members of the Board would like to hear your thoughts. We are interested! Remember, we have a "Notes and Quotes" column which we can use for this forum and would be more than happy to display membership opinions, A final note. The Board, officers and editors are also dues paying members and work for free. If anyone has a good high school basketball story to tell, please send it in. There are many, many tales from your different locales to tell. And they need to be told. Remember the axiom of some not pulling their weight. If two of a four team horse set refuse to pull their share of the load, the other two horses soon falter

To add to the difficulty many boxscores were never printed.


Wacky Times In Warrick County by Rocky Kenworthy

(Writer's note-this article is in no way meant to embarrass the good people of Warrick County, but to illustrate in a different age and time, the passionate, galvanizing effect high school basketball had on small communities in the 50's)

These tales of the tiny coal mining burgs of Tennyson and Elberfeld began early in the 1957-58 season. Tennyson, with two of the areas finest shooters in Jim Saltzman and Steve Phillips, plus 6-5 center George Barton, was seeking their first sectional title since their 'three-peat' (here's guessing that phrase was never uttered back then) of 1930, '31, and '32. Elberfeld, who never won a sectional title, had their starting five returning from the '57 club that finished 14-8. Rugged 6-3 southpaw forward Vince Gwaltney was one of Southern Indiana's best, and little Mary Schultz was the Hornet backcourt ace. With Boonville down, and defending sectional champ Lynnville decimated by graduation, Tennyson and Elberfeld fans looked toward the season with fervor. Maybe a little too much.

Tennyson's November trip to Troy (on the river in Perry County) provided the initial fireworks. Behind Saltzman's sniping, Tennyson's Tigers blasted to an early lead, but some of the Tiger faithful were becoming increasingly peeved with referee Al Paulin's decisions. When Paulin had heard enough, he summoned the Troy principal to eject some of the rowdiest fans. And when it became apparent that these coal miners weren't about to leave without their money's worth on a Friday night, the local Troy policeman ambled over to maintain order. Instead, he maintained the Sonny Liston position, down for the count, felled by a Tennyson booster's right hook. As both teams retreated to their dressing rooms, the brouhaha moved outside the gym. Sheriff and State Police finally gained the upper hand, and three Tennyson boosters spent the evening in jail, and \$24 each in fines. This possibly could be where the old punch-line, "Well judge, if that's all it's gonna cost me, I believe I'll go hit him again," gained legs. Anyway, no ruckus could stop a basketball game in Indiana in the 50's. Play resumed with Tennyson gaining an easy 80-43 triumph.

The Tigers, who dropped pre-Christmas contests to Oil Township (finished 18-2), Elberfeld, and a dandy

Griffin club, began to get rolling in January. Their season was about to get better, at least momentarily. The Dope Bag, originated by the short-lived Evansville Journal back in the 1920's, was a traveling trophy of some acclaim kept alive by the Evansville Courier newspaper. It actually was an 89 cent doctor's bag with accompanying fishing tackle box. It contained a ledger noting the particulars of how each winner gained control, and how long they held it. Any school from Vanderburgh, Dubois, Gibson, Pike, Perry, Posey, Spencer, and Warrick could garner the trophy by beating the team with current possession. The team maintaining the trophy at the end of the regular season kept it in their trophy case until the next basketball season. Tennyson hadn't gotten their mitts on "The Bag" in 26 years, but a January 22, 1958 date with Wadesville would change that. Behind Saltzman's 31, Wadesville abdicated the trophy to Tennyson, in a 74-64 decision.

The Tigers' first Dope Bag defense came at Spurgeon. The Cardinals had a good team led by high-scoring John Yager (who later coached at Tecumseh) and an even better timekeeper. With Tennyson clinging to a one-point, 72-71 lead, the Spurgeon clock operator "forgot" to start the clock for more than just a few seconds after a missed Tiger free throw, giving Spurgeon's Charlie Nixon

enough time to smack in the game winner at the gun. Tennyson was incensed. When Spurgeon officials asked for the Bag, Tennyson coach Woody Simpson informed them they were protesting the game to the IHSAA. With possession being 9/10ths of the law, and Tennyson, having previously fought the law, and the law won (song lyric in their somewhere), they couldn't take any chances. They took off for the bus, with Dope Bag in hand. Let the IHSAA sort it out.

In Spurgeon's first "defense" soto-speak, of the Dope Bag they didn't have, Chandler's Panthers knocked off the Cardinals, 71-51. When Chandler asked for the Bag, Spurgeon coach Jack Skinner replied, "You'll have to go to Tennyson to look for it." Chandler didn't have enough time to search. Three days later, Elberfeld's Hornets knocked off Chandler, 49-40. This was becoming a paper trail that would put Enron execs to shame. And sports writers uneasy. The Courier's innocent sports editor, Hall of Famer Dan Scism was feeling the heat. First Spurgeon, then Chandler, and now particularly Elberfeld fans were inquiring daily as to the whereabouts of their trophy.


Finally, two weeks after the Tennyson-Spurgeon timekeeper fiasco, the IHSAA, sorting through twenty pages

of game reports, upheld the contest as a 73-72 Spurgeon victory, which meant the trophy presently rightfully belonged to Elberfeld.


In reporting the IHSAA decision, and maybe breathing a premature sigh of relief, the Courier made a really bad choice, using the term "whistle stop" in reference to Elberfeld. Pass the Cloverine salve, because the wound just re-opened. Some Elberfeld people took it as a slam on their town, others took it that the Dope Bag wouldn't stay in Elberfeld long. The letters poured in. "Look buddy", one incensed Hornet wrote, "we have a good team and are proud of it. We'll beat Holland (who was 15-3) and Hazleton, and have the Bag until next season. You won't have nearly as much trouble keeping track of it as you are now." He proved correct. Another Elberfeld wag clipped the words "whistle stop", the Elberfeld 53-Holland 50 score, sent a box of salt and pepper, and said, "Now, eat it." Scism extended the olive branch by taking the trophy to each school who won it, snapping a team picture with it, and parking it in Elberfeld.

Alas, Lynnville Sectional time arrived (none too quickly for the Courier). It would be their last as host, as the 5000-seat Boonville gymnasium would open




Elberfeld High School

in the '58-'59 season. Elberfeld was the odds-on favorite at 15-5, but hot Tennyson had won nine of their last ten, with Spurgeon the only blemish. Neither got it done. Tennyson, went stone-cold (20-72 from the floor) against Newburgh on Saturday morning, and Elberfeld, after downing Boonville in the sectional semifinal, ran out of gas against a team they had beaten in the regular season, Keith Combs' Newburgh Wildcats in the sectional final, 64-54.

Class Basketball 1954 Style

There has been speculation as to what Milan's basketball classification would have been when applied to today's four class system. Researcher extraordinaire, Gary McGrady has come up with the enrollments for all 751 tournament participants. Quite an insight is to be had when viewing the different school sizes. Some schools will be larger than one might have thought, while others smaller.

For example, Carmel's 1954 enrollment of 224 seems paltry compared to them now being one of the ten largest schools in the state. Pike Twp. (Marion Co.) with an enrollment of 206 is another eye opener. Milan's enrollment of 161 would have put them in class 3A with the likes of Otwell, Patricksburg, Wheatfield, and West Twp. 




